

#### 2025 – YEAR OF DEDICATION

".....speak, for your servant is listening....."

[1 Samuel 3:10]





Dearly Beloved,

Greetings to you all in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!

Easter denotes east, the direction to which Christians turn to pray. The reason is that sunrise reminded to them the resurrection the Lord Jesus Christ for whom the title "the Sun of Righteousness" was claimed by Christians from the Old Testament prophets, "But for you who revere my name the sun of righteousness shall arise, with healing in its wing." (Malachi 4:2). Accordingly, the church buildings were built with alter facing east, and even if the alter was not on the eastern direction yet that end of the church was called east-end.

The festival Easter is at the heart of Christian faith. Here God's plan of our salvation is finally revealed. In fact each Sunday is an Easter. For this reason, Sunday is never a day for fasting even in the lent time. We will recall that Easter was celebrated the resurrection of the Lord Jesus in the Christian festival of Passover. You will remember that God passed over Egypt killing the first born but sparing the homes splashed with the blood of the lamb. This was a full moon night for the Hebrews

to start their journey to the land of liberty. Jesus also made his journey from death to life on Jewish Passover on the full moon night. Hence the Easter is also kept on a Sunday after the full moon night at the end of spring (lent) season. This could be any night after the 20 th of March. Easter is the Sunday after the full moon night. If the full moon is on a Sunday, then the Easter is on the following Sunday. This was to ensure that the Easter celebration avoids coinciding with the Jewish Passover. That is why date for Easter keeps shifting every year.

God created the world out of nothing, but later the people of God were made slaves in Egypt, the God were made slaves in Egypt, then God saved them freed them from Pharaoh. They travelled through the water of the Red Sea to promised land of Canaan. The readings (Genesis 1:15, 26-28,31, Exodus 4:27-5:1, Exodus 14:21-31, Romans 6:3-11 and Matthew 28:1-10) then tell the story of Jesus and his journey through death and resurrection which completes our salvation from the power of tyranny, sin and death. All these symbolize Christian baptism. Easter is a special day for Baptizing people. In our Baptism we also die to our old nature and like Christ we are resurrected to a new life. We also are freed from slavery of this sinful world and we enter the liberty of the Church of God. What happened to the Lord Jesus Christ occurs in us too. In this way we are joined to Christ in His death and His life.


